

CHANNAHON'S THREE RIVERS FESTIVAL

Celebrating the 175th **Anniversary of the I & M Canal**

Completed in 1848, and nearly 100 miles long, the I&M Canal was the final link in a national plan to connect different regions of North America via waterways. With the help of many immigrants, the 6-foot-deep canal was dug through the northern part of Will County and connected the cities of Channahon and Joliet to the east and west sections of the canal. The Will County towns of Joliet, Lockport and Channahon were three towns which prospered in the 19th century because of the transportation network that tied the county with Chicago and the East coast markets. The construction of the I&M Canal forever changed the nature of trade in the Illinois River valley. When the canal opened in 1848, trade that was once channeled through St. Louis was now directed to Chicago. Over time, the canal stimulated agricultural development in the region and prompted the growth of businesses in Chicago that were directly dependent on agriculture. In the first decade after the canal opened, the variety of products transported along the canal included wheat, corn, oats, flour, sugar, salt, pork, coal, stone and lumber. In Channahon, the I&M Canal crosses the DuPage River on the upstream side of the Channahon Dam. The canal is separated from either side of the river by a set of locks. Channahon State Park, a State park since 1932, sits at the juncture of the DuPage, Des Plaines and Kankakee rivers. Its name, then, is quite fitting: Channahon is an Indian word meaning "the meeting of the waters." It is the site of two of the I & M Canal locks #6 & #7 and the restored lock tender's house. The lock tender's house, constructed in 1848, was built along the west side of the lock. The Greek Revival-style structure was constructed in Lockport and floated down the canal to its present location.

CHANNAHON PARADE GRAND MARSHALLS John and Noreen Dollinger

The Dollinger Family came to the area around 1854, which is just after the completion of the I&M Canal. They settled along the Canal in an area called Bird's Bridge. John's father, J. Vernon Dollinger was born in the house his Grandfather first settled in. Vernon was born in 1909 and his birth certificate indicates Bird's Bridge as the place of his birth; which is located just west of I-55 where it goes over the canal. They farmed for many years there, as did Vernon's uncles. The farm that John and Noreen live on was from John's mother's side of the family. It is on Hansel Road as Jacob Hansel lived there. This was the site of the town of Dresden, established in 1836. Grandma's house was an Inn on the stagecoach line. The Mule Barn housed the mules that they switched along the canal. The Inn was important to the passengers along the canal. Jacob Hansel came to the area from the Alsace Lorraine area in the late 1840's. He worked as a hired hand for a few years until 1852 when he first purchased land here. In addition to all the fun things to do at John and Noreen's - Dollinger's Family Farm, there is also a lot of history to learn about while visiting including: the Mule Barn, Rutherford's Tavern, Milk House, the Bee Barn, Summer Kitchen, and the Old Cemetery
